



The Program's aims and basic parameters

The main aim of the Program is the creation of efficient gas industry in Eastern Russia which will serve as the basis for dynamic social and economic development of the region, improvement of living conditions of the local population.

- required investment is USD 100 billion;
- macroeconomic effect of the Program's realization is expected to be more than USD 770 billion
