## The Seventh Japan-Russia Energy and Environment Dialogue in Niigata The Niigata Appeal on Energy and the Environment 2014

30 October 2014 in Niigata City

Niigata has a long history of exchange with the countries on the opposite shores of the Sea of Japan, including Russia. Moreover, it is a base receiving energy resources, such as oil, natural gas, and coal, utilizing them in industry and in the civilian sector within the prefecture, and plays an important role as a hub for the transportation of oil and natural gas on to other regions of Japan. Considering such matters, the holding in Niigata of the "Japan-Russia Energy and Environment Dialogue" has great significance.
