A Study on China–Mongolia Cross-Border Logistics Transport Facilitation Matched to the Demands of Enterprises (Summary)

With the construction and advancement of the China–Mongolia–Russia economic corridor, there have been some new changes in the quantity and content of the cargo transportation between China and Mongolia. There still exist many problems in transportation cooperation between China and Mongolia, and they can't meet the demand of further development in bilateral economic cooperation. The enterprises engaged in logistics transport in Mongolia and China have put forward higher requirements on Mongolia's and China's cross-border logistics transport facilitation. This paper puts forward some measures

and suggestions to further improve the logistics transport facilitation between China and Mongolia in the light of the actual demand of enterprises, through analyzing and evaluating the cross-border logistics transport facilitation status and factors impacting it. Some proposals are put forward on the basis of domestic and international experience concerning coordination with economic policies, domestic coordination, construction of railways and roads, port construction, clearance facilitation, industry associations and enterprises.
